

Equipping your conference space with Wi-Fi 6E, gives you higher speeds and capacity, more reliability, and lower latency. You immediately support more users for bandwidth-hungry applications like video conferencing and streaming, IoT, whole-room gigabit coverage, cellular data offloading, and data transfer.

You can easily set up separate Wi-Fi networks for groups like guests, visiting employees, and vendor partners. Because this standard is backwards-compatible, Wi-Fi 6E access points and routers also support earlier iterations, including Wi-Fi 6 and Wi-Fi 5.

The Meraki MX security and SD-WAN appliance supports on-premises unified threat management (UTM) and Cisco Umbrella cloud security. Meraki simplifies the steps your network administrator needs to deploy and manage your architecture and infrastructure, dramatically slicing away complexity, cost, and time.


The MX features—like application-aware traffic control, content filtering, and intrusion

protection—help manage bandwidth and protect against digital threats. For example, you can filter non-business traffic, ban any device that's a potential security threat, and block unauthorized personal devices from connecting to the network—and you can prioritize video conferencing traffic.

After all, collaboration and communication technologies such as **Cisco Webex** mean remote attendees should never be an afterthought.

Furthermore, you can reduce energy and financial waste and improve ambiance with MT sensors. They provide insight into a room's environmental conditions—temperature, humidity, number of individuals, usage over time—that you can use to see whether these spaces are being maximized, could be better utilized, or repurposed.

By providing them with an SD-WAN, they have the same security as a corporate office with all the conveniences of home.

Add a Meraki MS switch and your executive team can connect core home-office technologies like computers, wireless access points, and IP phones. With a Meraki MR28 indoor access point, all employees have better throughput and reduced power consumption, so they'll get the most out of Wi-Fi 6.




Hotel room
